



# Tennis Auckland Board Vacancies

## Organisation and details

Tennis Auckland Region Incorporated (TA) is the largest of the New Zealand tennis regions comprising approximately 12,500 members in over 51 clubs. TA operates tennis centres in greater Auckland and successfully runs two international tennis tournaments in January each year. TA provides a Regional Development Programme for aspiring junior players and offers both administrative and technical support to its stakeholder clubs. Tennis Auckland website includes information on all facets of its operations.

The Board Appointments Panel is looking to formally appoint three (3) directors whose terms are concluding at the AGM. Nominations are sought for these appointed (1) and elected (2) positions.

As defined in the Constitution, the BAP is required to evaluate applicants based on the following criteria:

## Particular skills / competencies sought

Tennis Auckland is seeking applications from professionals with:

- Proven experience as a director, trustee and/or senior executive who have and understand highly effective governance skills
- Knowledge of, and experience in, the sport of tennis at international, national, regional and/or local level in New Zealand
- Occupational skills, abilities and experience
- Knowledge of, and experience in, sport generally
- The need for a wide range of skills and experience on Board

The Board having reviewed the skills within the current Board are interested in considering capabilities in the following areas:

- Strong financial competency
- Deep domestic/club knowledge/experience
- Competency in organisational strategy
- Risk Management
- ESG and Service Performance
- Human Resources skills
- Fundraising

Tennis Auckland supports the principle of gender equality at a governance level.

### **Commitment required**

All Board positions will be for a term of three years, unless a shorter term is determined by the Board Appointments Panel (for example, to deal with director rotations).

The successful candidates will join a capable Board, with a passion for tennis, who are collectively responsible for ensuring sound governance practices and processes in the Tennis Auckland region. Tennis Auckland Board meets a minimum of 8 times a year with most meetings taking approximately three hours. In addition to Board meetings, directors are involved in Board committees as relevant to their expertise and interests. These are voluntary roles.
